1 **The Paralympic Movement is strongest when we work together and support all members, valuing diversity, and ensuring inclusive development.** Internally IPC's regional organizations play an important role and we must support them to ensure that we can create better opportunities across the globe. During my time as President of NPC Denmark, we have secured equal rights for Danish Paralympians alongside Olympians.
